**GCOS Fall Show - October 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Krohn Conservatory - 1501 Eden Park Dr, Cincinnati, OH 45202.**

Reminder – Ken needs some help w/the Cincy show, folks. I don't know if anyone has volunteered yet or not so I wanted to send out another plea for assistance.

The Cincy Show is the weekend after our next meeting - Oct 22nd and 23rd - set up for the show being **Friday the 21st**.

Needed - volunteers to do the set up and tear down of the COOS exhibit. Either one person doing both OR a couple of people splitting it up.

Ken has done the show in the past but this year he can't stay in Cincy for the entire weekend. He is also involved in judging on Saturday so, for him, that would mean making the trip back and forth all three days.
